Turn left into Rosland Campground



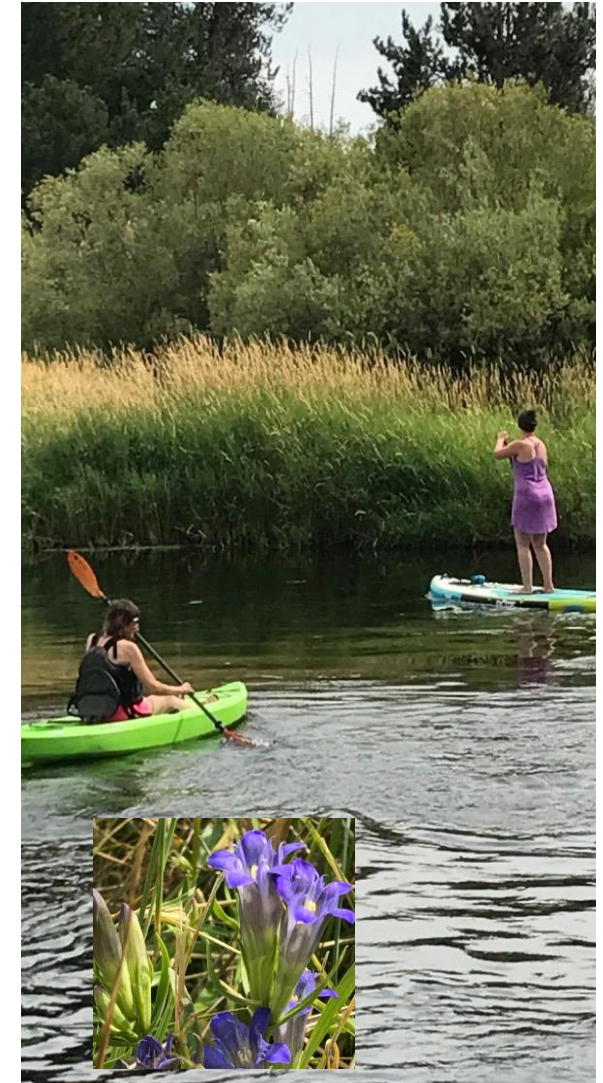

## Before You Go:

The park tends to be quiet on morning weekdays, getting more crowded after 3:00pm.
