

Hike, Ride, or Fish

The Chewaucan River offers unspoiled beauty above the high desert.. Access the Chewaucan River Loop, for mountain biking and OHV experiences. Fish the river, and hike the trails. One easily accessible place to fish is at Marsten Campground , 7 miles up Mill Road,. Paisley Fabric and Quilt is full of inspiration for quilters and carries Oregon Sunstone jewelry as well. Pick up lunch at Paisley Mercantile. Then head out for a day of fun!



Getting there:

Distance: 120 miles round trip; driving time 2.5 hours, paved & gravel roads

To Chewaucan River:

From La Pine Chamber of Commerce:
Turn right onto Hwy 97 S for 1.7 miles
Left on Hwy 31 (to Reno) for 98 miles
Paisley is just a block ahead on highway 31
Turn right on Mill Street for 7.7 miles
Parking lot and walking bridge on the left.
