


DESCHUTES COUNTY

- 1. Little Deschutes River at Rosland Park TROUT.
- 2. Big Deschutes River at Wyeth Campground, above Crane Prairie, and between Crane Prairie and Wickiup has boat and bank access for BROWN and RAINBOW TROUT.
- 3. Fall River headwaters has Fly Fishing only for TROUT
- 4. Paulina Lake and
- 5. East Lake have GERMAN BROWN, RAINBOW, KOKANEE and ATLANTIC SALMON
- 6. Big Deschutes River winds through La Pine State Park and fishing abounds. RED BAND and BROWN TROUT by boat or from the bank. The river runs 133 miles before it reaches Lake Billy Chinook. Always cold-even in the summer-it is deep and offers many levels with all of the challenges of a good fight! While you are there, look at the largest Ponderosa Pine tree in North America, known as Big Red.
- 7. Fall River at the falls, Fly Fishing only, is stocked with HATCHERY RAINBOWS, RED BAND, BROWNS and BROOK TROUT.
- **8-9. North and South Twin Lakes ,** are where you can catch large, trophy-type RAINBOWS.
- 10. Wickiup Reservoir, and ...
- **11. Crane Prairie** are where you fish for legendary CRANEBOWS, RED BAND, BASS, RAINBOWS, CATFISH, AND BLUEGILLS.
- Quinn River and Cultus Creek where they feed into Crane Prairie. BROOK TROUT
- 13-14. Big Cultus Lake for RAINBOWS and LAKE TROUT; Little Cultus Lake for Rainbows and Brook Trout.
- **15-16. Irish, and Taylor Lakes** are small and remote, with unimproved roads. Fish for RAINBOWS **and** BROOK TROUT.
- 17. Hosmer Lake Fly Fishing only for ATLANTIC SALMON, BROOK TROUT and RAINBOW TROUT.
- **18. Elk Lake** is a few miles further, where you can cast a line for RAINBOWS and BROOK TROUT.

The last stop on the north end is . . .

- 19. Lava Lake, where you can cast for 14-16 inch RAINBOWS and BROOK TROUT.
- **20**. **Little Lava Lake** (Headwaters of the Big Deschutes) Boat access is best.


KLAMATH COUNTY

- **21. Odell Lake at Shelter Cove and Odell Lake Lodges** are great places to fish. The lake has KOKANEE as well as TROUT.
- 22. Crescent Lake has LAKE TROUT and KOKANEE.
- 23. Crescent Creek is Fly Fishing only for TROUT.
- **24. Davis Lake** is **Fly Fishing only**. You'll find RAINBOW TROUT and LARGE MOUTH BASS. There is an unimproved boat launch on the lake.
- **25. Little Deschutes River at Mowich Road,** off Highway 58, is accessible year-round.
- **26. Miller Lake** is a large natural freshwater lake in Western Klamath County. You can catch GERMAN BROWNS and RAINBOWS in the lake.
- 27. Lemolo Lake has BROWNS and KOKANEE. It's a KOA destination.
- **28. Diamond Lake** is a year-round RAINBOW-producing fishery. Large RAINBOW run 14"-25" and Ice Fishing is popular in winter months.
- **29. Williamson River** is **Fly Fishing only** and close to Chiloquin off Highway 97. It has RAINBOW and REDBAND TROUT.
- **30. Wood River** is a **Fly fishing ONLY** paradise for RAINBOWS and GERMAN BROWNS.
- **31. Agency Lake** is a natural lake located west of Chiloquin. It is actually the northern arm of Upper Klamath Lake, connected by a narrow channel. A variety of fish including Rainbows and others.
- **32. Sprague River** is a tributary of the Williamson River that flows from the Fremont National Forest's Gearhart Mountain "Wildemess". There are tons of spring creeks in the "Wilderness" with NATIVE TROUT.



LAKE COUNTY

- **33. Buck Creek** is **Lure & Fly fishing ONLY.** It's between Bear Flat Road and Silver Lake. BROOKIES.
- **34. Thompson Reservoir** only 53 miles from La Pine is stocked with RAINBOWS and RED BANDS and also for fly-fishing, all around the lake will allow you to get your limits. There are several local fishing spots in the same locale on creeks located adjacent to the reservoir.
- **35. Duncan Reservoir**, near Silver Lake, is only 50 miles from La Pine and has a boat ramp and well-stocked RAINBOWS. Camping is usually available.
- **36. Ana Reservoir** is where you will find WHITE STRIPED BASS HYBIRDS and RAINBOW TROUT.
- **37. Chewaucan River** (Little Potato River) has spin casting and fly fishing. Its waters contain RED BAND TROUT and BROWN TROUT.



Cast a line to catch trout, kokanee, bass, and salmon on the Newberry Country Trail! Enjoy the lakes and rivers along the way and check with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to get seasonal information. Hook up with one of the local guides, listed inside.
