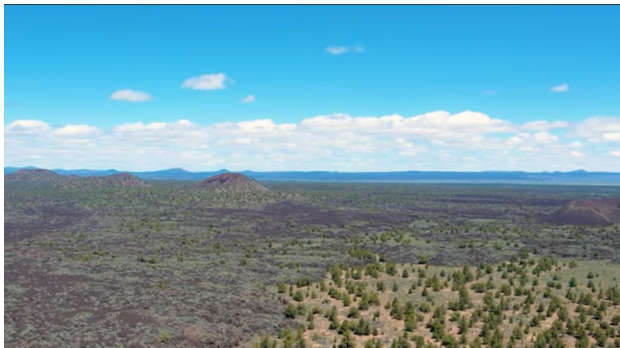


Desert Curiosities

can be found near Christmas Valley. Stop in at Coffee Corner Bistro for sandwiches, or head back for a lunch of Angus burgers and air fries before driving to Crack-in-the-Ground for the afternoon. Do the Dunes and Lost Forest in the morning; it is much cooler in the "crack" and can make a nice walk for the afternoon. Remember to take plenty of water. Don't rely on your GPS; you can't always get a signal. Be careful not to get stuck at the dunes; help and phone service can be a long ways away.

You can drive on to Green Mountain Campground to explore the lava flow, and Four Craters.

Before you go

Pick up at lunch at Coffee Corner Bistro at the corner of Park and Christmas Valley Highway, or stop back for lunch before going to Crack-in-the-Ground.

Crack-in-the-Ground has large boulders and tight squeezes to navigate. Be prepared to help children and maybe your small dog.
