Bring your toys . . .

and your curiosity. A trip that can be combined with Crack-in-the-Ground, the Dunes and Lost Forest are best visited in the morning during summer; it is much cooler in the "Crack" and can make a nice walk for the afternoon.

Remember to take plenty of water. Don't rely on your GPS; you can't always get a signal. A phone signal can be miles away, so printing out your maps is a good idea. Roads can be impassable after a rain or during shoulder seasons and winder Please stay on roads in the forest and practice leaving no trace. .

The wildness and quiet of this area can be compelling, And at night, you can touch the stars.


