Remember to take plenty of water. Don't rely on your GPS; you can't always get a signal. A phone signal can be miles away, so printing out your maps is a good idea. Roads can be impassable after a rain or during shoulder seasons and winter. Please stay on roads in the forest and practice leaving no trace. .
