


Family fun ... Right in town!

Turn left into Rosland Campground





Before You Go

The park tends to be quiet on morning week-days, getting more crowded after 3:00pm.

There is no life guard on duty, so children should be supervised at all times. When playing at the landing, watch out for approaching kayaks and canoes.

Dogs must be on leash.

Amenities

Covered picnic area, grill, prep area, water, electricity, restrooms, swing set, soft landing for individual watercraft like canoes.

Bring with you

Sun screen, bug repellent, sun hats, food, frisbees, inner tubes, water and beach toys, water shoes, swim/life vests, towels, binoculars, and a book.
