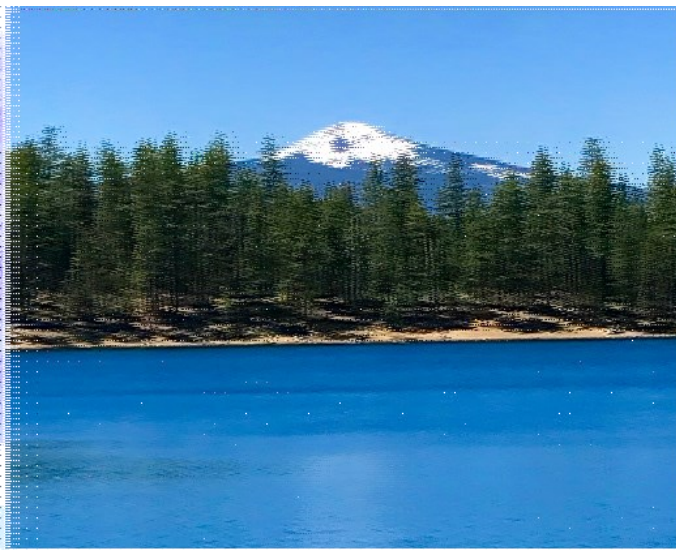

## Before You Go:

**Get your fishing license before you go. The National Park Day Use pass is available at the resort.**

Any of the following Interagency Passes are valid: Annual, Military, Senior, Access, 4th Grade, or Northwest Forest. **Fishing licenses are available at Bi-Mart, and at Ace Hardware.**



## Amenities:

The Day Use area has restrooms, water, picnic tables, and paved parking.

The Lakeshore Loop trail is about 1.7 miles. Animals to look for include bald eagles, osprey, ducks, dragonflies, and frogs.
