

Clear, Clean Water:

One of the purest lakes in the world is right in our backyard!. Bring your kayak, canoe, electric motor boat (NO internal combustion engines allowed!) or inner tube for a great day of swimming, fishing and boating. The shallow water is usually warm by mid-July and perfect for a day with the dog and the kids. The water is clear to 100 feet deep, and the blue color is unsurpassed.



Getting there:

To Manley's Tavern:

Turn left on Highway 97 for 17 miles.

Right on Crescent Cutoff Rd for 12 miles

Right on OR-58 for 3.5 miles

Right into parking lot. Manley's Tavern,
20005 OR 58

To Waldo Lake: Continue north on OR-58
for 10 miles

Turn right at the sign for Waldo Lake for 13
miles

Arrive at North Waldo Picnic Area and Boat
Launch
